
Single route

- 1 Walk up the driveway beside the hotel past the Kids' Zone until you meet the main road. Turn left and walk to Brackenrigg Inn.
- 2 Turn right at the Brackenrigg Inn and follow the road uphill for 20 minutes.
- 3 After reaching Wreay, a small farming hamlet, take the road right, signposted to Dacre. Continue along this road for 10 minutes.
- You'll pass a farm on your right, after 200 m you will see a sign marked with the Ullswater Way daffodil to Waterfoot campsite. Take this footpath and follow it to the campsite.
- 5 Once you have reached the campsite, follow the signs to Pooley Bridge.
- 6 Take the footpath that follows the lake around to Pooley Bridge. If your destination is the Ullswater Steamer then you will pass this on your right as you follow the path to Pooley Bridge.
- 7 Walk over the bridge to get to the pubs and shops.



Another Place to Pooley Bridge


